Jarosh: I spoke with Dave Dozak and he said Corey did a great job last year.

Comments:

Gangemi: Tom what do we have to do to get Jack Scheuer started n the plan for 48 acres? We have to get a plan.

Lukasewicz: We got a good grip on it. Getting the road in is most important, trying to work on the utilities, next step is to get guys in there to do some digging and we need to go as a group to decide on a central spot for pavilion or something, an open spot for the starters, for the future.

Gangemi: if we get the extension for the \$40,000.00, then we could, with that plan in place, build the parking lot with that money.

Lukasewicz: If we do get that extension Louie.

Attorney Cimini: We won't find out about the extension until sometime in the end of August or beginning of September.

Lukasewicz: When we get the extension we will have the money for September to do the parking lot. I'm hoping everything falls into place now. Jack is optimistic.

Gangemi: We lost opportunity for grants, if we don't have that master plan ready.

Lukasewicz: The wind energy is something we should incorporate into the master plan.

Gangemi: The low profile ones may be enough.

Jarosh: The question is how much do they generate?

Gangemi: Right, how much do they generate, how much will it cost to get it back to the grid.

Lukasewicz: We were anticipating putting in the electric and might not need it, we may need special electric.

Jarosh: Normal lines, we still need the line, it travels in both directions.

Lukasewicz: We need to get a plan.

Gangemi: We do. How much money do we have left?

Robin: about \$330,000.00.

Gangemi: We'll use some of that for the engineering.

Lukasewicz: May have \$400,000.00 to work with that will be eaten up by the road going in and the utilities going in.

Jarosh: The wind turbines that I was looking at are 30 feet high.

Gangemi: Need to do a cost analysis.

Lukasewicz: They'll do that.

Jarosh: I've done it.

Gangemi: What's the turnaround on it?

Jarosh: Can pay it off in less than 10 years.

Lukasewicz: If we do put the wind turbines in, in the future will look better because we are going green.

Gangemi: We need a plan to get it going.

Lukasewicz: Next mid month meeting, start it at 6:00 and have Jack Scheuer here to discuss this. By then Robert should have a better idea what he needs. We'll all go up there on a Sunday as an Executive and walk around. A day towards the beginning of next month.

Mayor Lukowski: I made the decision to deny the handicapped request. I will talk with Robert about other options we can come up with besides taking another parking spot from there.

Lukasewicz: The letter regarding dog walking is not handed out yet.

Mayor Lukowski: I will get with Keith tomorrow because I said I wanted a log and he said he'll do an incident report on each letter handed out. I will address it.

Furiosi: Mayor, get with Keith and let him know there are some complaints on Brick Street behind Sam's Bar. There is a lot of activity there. Tell him to beef up the patrol behind the bar. Also if you would ask Keith to send Robin an inventory list of what he has over there. Cars, weapons, patches, etc.

Lukasewicz: Let's request inventory of all departments by 2 months.
