To adopt Throop Borough Resolution #2 of 2014, authorizing the reappointment of Robert Kokinda as a member of the Throop Borough Zoning Hearing Board for a three year term expiring January 13, 2017.

2. Motion by Mazak **Seconded by Repchick**

To advertise Ordinance #2 of 2014, an ordinance restricting parking for the full length along the Northwesterly side of Dewey Street and within fifty feet of the intersection along the Southeasterly side of Haverly Street as well as within fifty feet each of the intersection of Sanderson Street.

Lukasewicz added that a traffic study was done.

To advertise Ordinance #3 of 2014, an ordinance restricting parking for the full length along the Northwesterly side of Haverly Street and within thirty feet of the intersection of Sanderson Street, along the Southeasterly side of Haverly Street.

To adopt Resolution #3 of 2014 appointing David Karr to fulfill the remaining term of Wayne Williams on the Civil Service Commission expiring on July 28, 2015.

To adopt Resolution #4 of 2014 appointing Frank Galli on the Civil Service Commission for a six year term.

To promote Kim O'Connor from a part time civic center employee to a full time civic center employee at the same pay rate and with all Borough benefits starting immediately.

Official Comments:

Tomasovitch wants something done with parking on Green Street during the Bar hours because the fire trucks won't be able to get through. There are no parking signs on Yerke's side.

Tomasovitch was approached by a resident regarding speeding on Loftus St by the Washington St park playground.

Mayor Williams asked if there is reduced speed limits by the parks.

Repchick added that it is 25 mph Borough wide by vehicle code unless posted.

Tomasovitch also added that Farina's Office is having a shred event on Wednesday at 423 Main Street.

O'Malley asked for permission to schedule a shredding event again this year on the first Saturday in June.
