

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1 OF 2012

ADOPTING AND AMENDING A MOTION MADE AT A THROOP BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING ON DECEMBER 27, 1958 TO INCREASE THE TAX RATE TO ONE PERCENT (1%) ON SALARIES, WAGES, COMMISSIONS, COMPENSATION, NET PROFIT AND OTHER REVENUES RECEIVED OR EARNED WITHIN THROOP BOROUGH BY NON-RESIDENTS.

WHEREAS, on December 27, 1958 Throop Borough Council passed a motion to impose a tax rate of .5% on salaries, wages, commissions, compensation, net profit and other revenues received or earned within the Borough of Throop by non-residents thereof; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Throop Borough Council to adopt a recommendation made by Throop Borough Assistant Treasurer to raise the tax for non-residents to 1%.

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Throop as follows:

1. *The tax on salaries, wages, commissions, compensation, net profit and other revenues received or earned within Throop Borough by non-residents shall be increased to one percent (1%).*

SECTION 1.

If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough of Throop reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Ordinance and the effective administration thereof.


SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval.


SECTION 3.


