2 evidently we need another contact person, so
3 let's make a motion to include Mr. Green to
4 the list of contact persons for the EMA
5 management.
6 MR. BARNICK: It has to be done by
7 resolution and sworn in? Do you know if
8 they have to be sworn in or not?
9 MAYOR LUKOWSKI: When you get the
10 other two people here.
11 MR. LUKASEWICZ: All right, audience
12 comments on that motion?
13 MS. JOHNSON: I'd like to add a
14 motion to pay me my monthly stipend that I
15 didn't get paid yet.
16 MR. LUKASEWICZ: One motion will be
17 for the EMA. Fifteen would be a motion to
18 request payment by Councilwoman Johnson to
19 receive December and -- any other ones?
20 MS. JOHNSON: No, that's fine for

23 MRS. MORRELL: I did receive quotes
24 on a copier similar to what we have now. No
25 color. Black and white copier that sorts,

1 staples, two-sided. We've received a price
2 quote from Top Copy, GBM, and Keystone
3 Business Products, and the best price for a
4 comparable copier is Top Copy. The total
5 was \$6,660 and the service fee is .011 per
6 copy. And their maintenance agreement
7 covers everything including toner, the drum.
8 All your service costs included. Like I
9 said, the prices were very close.
10 The next price was GBM, \$6,684.64.
11 Their maintenance is a little bit higher. I
12 think it's about \$21 higher.
13 And then Keystone Business Products,
14 their price was \$7,092.50. Top copy was the
15 lowest price.
16 MR. LUKASEWICZ: What's the cost?
17 MRS. MORRELL: \$6,660, and then
18 there is a maintenance agreement of .011 per
19 copy. They could bill quarterly or
20 annually. I would suggest quarterly on
21 maintenance.
22 MR. LUKASEWICZ: And the other
23 copier can just be taken over the civic
24 center?
25 MRS. MORRELL: Sure. It functions

1 as a one-sheet copier. You'd have to buy an
2 entire new unit for a stapler and feeder.
3 MR. LUKASEWICZ: All right, we'll
4 have that motion on also. So audience
5 comment on those three motions that we just
6 discussed? Anyone?
7 (Jack Dolan inquired about comparing
8 copier prices.)
9 MR. LUKASEWICZ: Anyone else?

25 MS. JOHNSON: When I receive

something from the borough we can discuss that but I'd still like to read something.

"As it has been reported in the media that the borough of Throop is hiring a lawyer to remove me from my council -- Throop council seat, I have been advised by counsel not to comment concerning this matter since it is in litigation. Since the action of the majority of council are political and are being made in bad faith, I will provide proof of residency to the proper independent authorities and proceed to have my legal fees paid by Throop Borough, just as the majority did."

MR. BARNICK: Good for you.

MS. JOHNSON: Thank you.

2 MR. CHRZAN: I'll make it.


