1 (Whereupon the Pledge of Allegiance
2 was recited.)

3 MR. LUKASEWICZ: Roll call, please.

4 MRS. MORRELL: Johnson is absent.

5 Barnick?

6 MR. BARNICK: Here.

7 MRS. MORRELL: Lukasewicz?

8 MR. LUKASEWICZ: Present.

9 MRS. MORRELL: Chrzan?

10 MR. CHRZAN: Present.

11 MRS. MORRELL: Marushock is absent.

12 Musewicz?

13 MR. MUSEWICZ: Present.

14 MRS. MORRELL: Barone?

15 MR. BARONE: Present.

16 MRS. MORRELL: Attorney Cimini?

17 MR. CIMINI: Present.

18 MRS. MORRELL: Mayor Lukowski?

19 MAYOR LUKOWSKI: Here.

20 MRS. MORRELL: Dolan?

21 MRS. DOLAN: Present.

22 MRS. MORRELL: Sullivan?

23 MS. SULLIVAN: Here.

24 MR. LUKASEWICZ: Announcements. An
25 executive session was held this evening at

1 6:15 p.m. to discuss legal and personnel
2 matters. A special general purpose work
3 session followed by a meeting will be held
4 on Thursday, April 6, 2006, beginning at
5 6:30 p.m. Bids will be opened for the DPW
6 complex.

7 Lackawanna County EMA is sponsoring
8 NIMS IS-700 National Incident Management
9 System on Monday, April 24, 2006, 8:30 a.m.
10 to 12:30 p.m. at the Throop Municipal
11 Building.

12 Before I go to audience comments, we
13 do have one of the candidates for the 113th
14 district here this evening, Mr. O'Boyle.
15 He's come here once before and he's here
16 again this evening. Do you have anything
17 you want to say while you're here tonight?

18 (Mr. O'Boyle addressed council on
19 the public forum.)

20 MR. LUKASEWICZ: My main concern is
21 to get the best person for the job. This
22 will get it out a lot quicker than any other
23 way. Thanks for coming this evening.

24 We will begin with audience comments
25 on tonight's agenda. State your name and

1 address for the record. Address your
2 concerns to me, I'll try to answer it. If I
3 can't, someone else from council will.
4 First row? Second row? Third row?

5 (Dominic Rocco, 110 Sanderson
6 Street, inquired about the bids for the pump
7 house.)

8 MR. LUKASEWICZ: It will probably go
9 out, I would say, sometime next week.
10 Usually we allow a couple weeks or a month.
11 It won't be April 6. It won't come back
12 that fast. I'd say we probably wouldn't
13 have it back until the end-of-the-month
14 meeting.

15 Next row? In the back?

16 (Mary Ruth Tanner, 1101 Marshwood
17 Road, discussed the youth basketball program
18 and the fifth grade basketball team and
19 organizing a fund raiser for jackets.)

20 MR. LUKASEWICZ: Attorney Cimini
21 will look into that and we'll give you an
22 answer for the next meeting. But again,
23 it's commendable that they did good.

24 MR. BARONE: You have to straighten
25 that situation out with the maintenance man.

1 (Ms. Tanner also discussed the civic
2 center maintenance.)

3 MR. LUKASEWICZ: My suggestion right
4 now is handle it internally, however you
5 have to do it, and we'll look to the future
6 of coming up with a game plan to do it
7 solidly. But whatever you need right now
8 you can take care of it. Good enough?
9 We're proud of that facility and I want to
10 highlight that when we have our
11 representatives come here so we don't want
12 it in disrepair.

13 (Ms. Tanner also informed council of
14 the Easter party and discussed the high
15 school dance.)

16 MR. LUKASEWICZ: I believe it to be
17 a great idea because basically there is no
18 place for our younger kids to go that age.
19 But coordinate this and keep council and the
20 committee and the police and everybody in
21 the loop just to avoid any situation.

22 MAYOR LUKOWSKI: It might be a good
23 idea to consider a live band instead of just
24 spinning records.

25 MR. LUKASEWICZ: Look, it's a great

1 idea. I think it's a wonderful idea. Can I
2 suggest that it be for Mid Valley students
3 only, that they have to show their ID?
4 Because everyone has a school ID, I believe,
5 every student. Right? We have an Easter
6 egg hunt for people just from Throop so we
7 can have a dance for whoever we want to
8 have. I'm just saying, I think to avoid
9 problems, if it was specifically Mid Valley
10 students it would be a lot easier, because
11 if not you're going to have boyfriends and
12 girlfriends coming in from other towns and
13 that's when you're going to have the fights.

14 MR. CHRZAN: Get a cross-reference
15 from the school and then you can check them
16 out.

17 MR. LUKASEWICZ: It's a good idea.
18 Maybe you can coordinate it with one of the
19 clubs at school, a member of one of the
20 clubs. It's a great idea.

21 All right. Going across towards the
22 open doorway?

23 (Joseph Gerrity, 616 Edgar Street,
24 inquired if anything was being done about
25 the speeding cars on Hickory Street.)

1 MR. LUKASEWICZ: The mayor is in
2 charge of the police. What I'm going to
3 suggest -- you came here with a legitimate
4 concern. Stanley, if you can do something
5 to have the police watch, and then if you --

6 MAYOR LUKOWSKI: That is a hazardous
7 area.

8 MR. LUKASEWICZ: Stanley, you'll
9 make it a priority for us, please.

10 Mr. Gerrity, if you keep us
11 informed. Call Elaine Morrell, who is the
12 borough chief clerk, and if you let her know
13 what's going on there, then she'll notify
14 the rest of the council. This way we can be
15 kept in the loop.

16 All right, coming down.

17 (Patrol Officer William Hazelton
18 invited council to attend the DARE class
19 graduation at the elementary center and
20 expressed his gratitude for purchasing the
21 graduation presents. He also advised
22 council of the Night Out meeting.)

23 MR. LUKASEWICZ: All right, we'll

1 Motion number two, to accept the
2 zoning reports and the transcripts/minutes
3 of the December 22, 2005, January 3,
4 February 9, 2006, and the March 9, 2006
5 (work session/meeting) council meetings.

6 MR. CHRZAN: I'll make it.

7 MR. LUKASEWICZ: Motion by Tony.

8 MR. BARONE: I'll second.

9 MR. LUKASEWICZ: Second by Mr.
10 Barone. On the question? Roll call.

11 MR. BARNICK: On the question, our
12 girls are doing very good. We're
13 straightening everything out that was messed
14 up.

15 MR. LUKASEWICZ: You know, you hit a
16 good spot, Joe. Things are good in Throop.
17 You know, things were good in Throop.
18 Things got astray because we weren't allowed
19 to do what we always did as a group. And

12 And what it includes is basically the design
13 of the DPW complex, which usually is quite
14 substantial to design a building of that
15 magnitude. Roll call, please.

9 you could include on it my cell phone
10 number, that if there are any problems
11 associated with the project that they can
12 either contact the borough here or contact
13 me directly. I want to know what's going on
14 there at all times so I can keep you guys
15 filled in. It's going to be a big project.
16 I just don't want to have any problems.

17 The next motion, to proclaim April
18 21 to the 23rd, 2006, the National and
19 Global Youth Service Days in Throop Borough.
20 We urge all citizens to participate in
21 helping our youth to apply their potential
22 to serve the community.

22 the youth of our community.

23 (Donna Maass, 452 Delaware Street,
24 questioned about the project on Delaware
25 Street.)

1 MR. LUKASEWICZ: Eddy, Franko and
2 Delaware there will be a project, \$250,000.
3 Basically the sanitary sewers, the storm
4 lines, and complete reconstruction of the
5 road. It's going to be quite lengthy and
6 substantial. So the citizens that live
7 there are probably going to have to bear
8 with it. That's why I mentioned to Elaine
9 Morrell we're going to get a letter out to
10 all the citizens that live there, and my
11 phone number will be on it. Feel free to
12 contact me or Elaine.

13 If you have some free time come and
14 see Robert Kalinoski. He's the zoning
15 officer and street commissioner. He'll
16 probably be overseeing the entire project,
17 so if you can give him your concerns now he
18 can work with you.

19 MR. BARNICK: It won't be dug up all
20 at one time.

21 MR. LUKASEWICZ: It's going to be
22 shortly. Within the next couple weeks they
23 should start. Usually when a project is
24 done, usually it's done in such a way that
25 you're not inconvenienced completely that

1 you can't park there that day. Maybe for a
2 few hours you'll be inconvenienced but
3 usually you have the opportunity to park
4 somewhere. Again, if you have any concerns,
5 see Mr. Kalinoski and tell him your
6 concerns. We'll try to work around them.
7 Thank you.

9 business for us at this time?

10 MAYOR LUKOWSKI: I don't have
11 anything.

12 MR. LUKASEWICZ: Any other new
13 business from any council?

14 If not, then any new business from
15 the audience? We'll start in the front and
16 work back. First row? Second row?

17 (Bette Goreschak inquired about the
18 stenographer.)

19 MR. LUKASEWICZ: He's not here but
20 he's recording. Next row? In the back?

21 (Mary Ruth Tanner inquired about the
22 National Global Youth Service.)

23 MR. LUKASEWICZ: It's a great idea.
24 Anything where you recognize kids has got to
25 be a good idea. First time I've ever heard

1 of it. I don't know where it came from on
2 the agenda but it's a great idea.

3 MR. BARNICK: University of
4 Scranton. I was reading it today.
