

Ordinance # 10 of 2011

2011 COMPLIANCE AMENDMENT TO THE THROOP BOROUGH POLICE PENSION PLAN

AS IS authorized by Section 19 of Ordinance No. 8 of 2003 and Section 17 of Ordinance No. 14 of 1996, Throop Borough Act 600 Police Pension Fund, Throop Borough does hereby amend the Police Pension Plan Ordinance to comply with Act 600 of 1956 as amended by Act 51 of 2009, the Emergency and Law Enforcement Personnel Death Benefits Act. This amendment shall be effective immediately as provided herein. This amendment shall supersede the provisions of the pension plan to the extent those provisions are inconsistent with provisions of this amendment. Throop Borough hereby amends the pension plan as follows:

- 1. Repeal of Killed-in-Service Benefit, Section 14 of Ordinance No.: 8 of 2003 and any other section in Ordinance No.: 8 of 2003 and Ordinance No.: 14 of 1996 are hereby amended to remove, in their entirety, any and all provisions regarding the Killed-in-Service Benefit.*
- 2. This amendment is made effective immediately upon execution and in any interpretation shall be retroactive to December 29, 2011.*
- 3. All other provisions of the plan remain in full force and effect.*
- 4. The Commonwealth will assume the financial burden of the Act 600 Killed-in-Service benefit.*
