

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2 OF 2007

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING
ON SANDERSON STREET/MARSHWOOD ROAD (S.R. 2008)
FROM HALL STREET TO KEYSTONE INDUSTRIAL PARK ROAD AND ON
UNDERWOOD ROAD EXTENDING 1000 FEET FROM ITS INTERSECTING WITH
SANDERSON STREET/MARSHWOOD ROAD (S.R. 2008)

WHEREAS, parking restrictions are the responsibility of Throop Borough; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council determined that it is in the best interest of Throop Borough to ban parking, as identified, to promote public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Throop Police Department and Throop inhabitants have expressed concern in relation to vehicles parking on the aforementioned roadways thereby reducing site distances and making travel unsafe.

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 1.

Parking is hereby prohibited on both sides of Sanderson Street/Marshwood Road (S.R. 2008) from Hall Street to Keystone Industrial Park Road and on Underwood Road extending 1000 feet from its intersecting with Sanderson Street/Marshwood Road (S.R. 2008).

Section 2.

In addition, parking is prohibited on or about the triangle shaped island where Underwood Road meets Sanderson Street/Marshwood Road (S.R. 2008).

Section 3.

The Throop Borough Official in charge of signage will post Sanderson Street/Marshwood Road (S.R. 2008) from Hall Street to Keystone Industrial Park Road and Underwood Road extending 1000 feet from its intersecting with Sanderson Street/Marshwood Road (S.R. 2008) and the triangle shape island where Underwood Road meets Sanderson Street/Marshwood Road (S.R. 2008) with No Parking signs.

Section 4.

This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Throop Police Department with full police powers to enforce compliance with said Ordinance.

Section 5.

If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough of Throop reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Ordinance and the effective administration thereof.

Section 6.


This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval.

This Ordinance is enacted by the Council of the Borough of Throop under the authority of the Act of the Legislative, as amended, December 12, 1990, P.L. 1994, No. 220, and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
