ORDINANCE NUMBER 2 OF 2012

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO PENNSYLVANIA BOROUGH CODE SECTION 1731 TO OPEN BUSH STREET (FORMERLY HUDSON STREET) WHICH LIES ON THE NORTHEAST SIDE OF DIVISION STREET.

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania Borough Code Section 1731 authorizes, by ordinance, the opening of any street; and,

WHEREAS, recently Throop Borough Council requested the removal of barriers located at the northeasterly end of Bush Street, just north of the intersection of Bush Street and Division Street; and,

WHEREAS, Throop Borough Street Commissioner removed the barriers in conjunction with a recent water main improvement project conducted on behalf of Pennsylvania American Water Company; and,

WHEREAS, said portion of Bush Street which was previously unimproved has been surfaced as a result of the aforementioned project.

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Throop as follows:

- 1. Bush Street (formerly Hudson Street), which lies on the northeast side of Division Street, shall be opened in accordance with the procedures said forth in Borough Code Section 1731.
 - 2. Said portion of Bush Street shall be a public street of Throop Borough.
- 3. In addition, a Stop sign shall be installed and located along the southbound lane of Bush Street at its intersection with Division Street.
- 4. In addition, a Stop sign and an Except Right Turn sign shall be installed and located along the northbound lane of Bush Street at its intersection with Division Street.

SECTION 1.

If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains

legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough of Throop reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Ordinance and the effective administration thereof.

SECTION 2,

This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after its enactment.

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance is enacted by the Council of the Borough of Throop under the authority of the Act of the Legislative, as amended, December 12, 1990, P.L. 1994, No. 220, and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
