Audience comments:

Frank Galli: Thanked everyone for the Little League Project. No more flooding on the field.

Jim Barnick, Adams Ct: Questioned if the DPW Roof is going to be designed. The original architect was supposed to back this.

Also stated that the LL park looks great but should've paved the parking lot. It's hard to walk on. Put a handicapped person on that - it's terrible. Go the final stretch..

Lukasewicz added that will look at it for the budget next year.

Gangemi questioned if he (Jim) forgot that the landfill is going to close.
A discussion regarding the landfill status took place.

Bob Magliocchi, Bruno Dr.: Commented on the handicapped pad at the boys field and that there is no sidewalk to get from the pad to the concession stand. Handicapped people are trapped.
Lukasewicz said that they were good points that need to be addressed at budget time.
Mazak added that it would be another \$500,000.00 to pave it.

Magliocchi also spoke of the porto potties and the door that was installed in the borough building.

Mazak questioned how handicapped people get in this building. We have a problem right here.
