

ORDINANCE NUMBER 6 of 2007

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF MUNICIPAL WASTE; REQUIRING PREPARATION, MANNER AND FREQUENCY OF COLLECTION AND AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, it is the purpose of this ordinance to protect the public health, safety and welfare from the hazards of the accumulation of uncollected municipal waste.

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Throop as follows:

Section 1 Administration.

All borough residential refuse generated within Throop Borough shall be collected, conveyed and disposed of by the Borough of Throop once per week, either directly by borough employees or by such contractor or contractors as Throop Borough may employ for purposes of collection and removal of refuse.

Section 2 Prohibited Acts.


No person shall obstruct, delay or interfere with the refuse collectors while in the performance of their duties or enter into any controversies with the collectors, nor shall any person violate any of the provisions of this ordinance with regard to the disposal of garbage, rubbish and ashes, or the containers for the same or violate any of the provisions with respect to the collection and removal of refuse, rubbish and ashes.

Section 3 Severability.

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not effect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or part of this ordinance. It is hereby the intent of the Borough of Throop that this ordinance would have been adopted had such constitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval.
