

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 7 OF 2006**

**AN ORDINANCE WHEREBY THROOP BOROUGH CONDITIONALLY ACCEPTS THE STREETS/PAVED ROAD SURFACES IN SCHOOLSIDE ESTATES SOLELY TO ALLOW DELIVERY OF MAIL, PLOWING OF STREETS, PAVED ROAD SURFACES, COLLECTION OF GARBAGE/RECYCLING AND SCHOOL BUS SERVICE.**

*WHEREAS, Schoolside Estates is a named development constructed in Throop Borough; and*

*WHEREAS, pursuant to Borough Code Section 1734, Throop Borough Council may, by Ordinance, accept any open street not previously dedicated or laid out by Throop Borough; and*

*WHEREAS, Schoolside Estates requested that Throop Borough accept the streets/paved road surfaces in the development by a Deed of Dedication; and*

*WHEREAS, Throop Borough Council's acceptance of the streets/paved road surfaces within Schoolside Estates is conditioned upon additional construction/improvements by the developer/owners/contractors of Schoolside Estates (as per Robert Bernosky's recommendation) and is accepted solely to allow delivery of mail, plowing of streets, paved road surfaces, collection of garbage/recycling and school bus service.*

*NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by Throop Borough Council and it is hereby ordained as follows:*


- 1. Pursuant to Borough Code Section 1734, et al, Throop Borough hereby conditionally accepts the streets/paved road surfaces in Schoolside Estates solely to allow delivery of mail, plowing of streets, paved road surfaces, collection of garbage/recycling and school bus service. Throop Borough will not accept a Deed of Dedication unless and until Schoolside Estates completes construction/improvements as per Robert Bernosky.*

*SECTION 1. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough of Throop reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Ordinance and the effective administration thereof.*


**SECTION 2.** *This ordinance shall become effective forty (40) days after enactment.*

**SECTION 3.** *This Ordinance is enacted by the Council of the Borough of Throop under the authority of the Act of the Legislative, as amended, December 12, 1990, P.L. 1994, No. 220, and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.*
