

ORDINANCE NUMBER 8 OF 2011

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING RESTRICTION ALONG THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF THE EASTERLY SIDE OF CHARLES STREET FROM THE BOROUGH LINE AT PANCOAST STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH NORTH STREET AND A PARKING RESTRICTION ON THE WESTERLY SIDE OF CHARLES STREET WITHIN THIRTY (30) FEET OF ITS INTERSECTION WITH PANCOAST STREET AND WITHIN 30 FEET OF ITS INTERSECTION OF THE 400 BLOCK OF EDGAR STREET

WHEREAS, pursuant to 67 Pa. Code Chapter 201 (Pa. Dot. Pub. 201) the Street Commissioner conducted a review/study of a section of the 100 and 200 block of Charles Street between the intersections of North Street and Pancoast Street; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to said reviews/study of said intersection, a recommendation was made by the Street Commissioner; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to said study it was recommended that a no parking restriction be enforced along the entire length of the easterly side of Charles Street from the Borough line of Pancoast Street to its intersection with North Street and a parking restriction be imposed and enforced on the westerly side of Charles Street within 30 feet of its intersection with Pancoast Street and within 30 feet of its intersection of the 400 block of Edgar Street; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Throop Borough Council to accept and adopt said recommendation.

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Throop as follows:

- 1. Throop Borough hereby adopts the recommendation of the Street Commissioner as it appears in an engineering and traffic study dated November 2011.*
- 2. In conjunction with said recommendation, a no parking restriction along the entire length of the easterly side of Charles Street from the Borough line at Pancoast Street to its intersection with North Street and a parking restriction be posted and enforced on the westerly side of Charles Street within 30 feet of its intersection with Pancoast Street where the width is reduced to less than 27 feet and within 30 feet of its intersection of the 400 block of Edgar Street where sight distance is restricted due to the terrain.*

SECTION 1.

If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough of Throop reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Ordinance and the effective administration thereof.


SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval.


SECTION 3.


