**Official Comments:**

Musewicz spoke of letter he received from Bernie Walko.

Lukasewicz: The easement for relocation of sewer line should be our responsibility instead of DEP procuring an easement for the property owner. Need to send a letter back that we disagree with their letter completely and when we installed this sewer line in conjunction with Eddy Creek Phase I they showed us the parameters where this sewer line should go. Why now when they decide to change the sewer line and stream location, why years later, do they want us to pay or get involved with an easement for something they told us the wrong information for back then. We built it according to their plans and now they want to put the burden on us. Attorney Cimini prepare something and have it available for all of Council to review before it is sent.

Tomasovitch asked about getting Mayor Tags to put on the signs at all entrances to Throop.

Lukasewicz asked that it be run by Robert if it is feasible. Also could include meeting schedule.

Tomasovitch: At planning meeting and schoolside estates is having sewer problems. Backing up into someone's home. Sewer authority was there and out on street is Kosik's problem.

Lukasewicz: Attorney Cimini, Bob and Robert investigate and give something to us in writing so we know what is going on.

Repchick questioned why Planning didn't tell Council.

Lukasewicz advertise for summer help and contact who was here in the past if they are interested because always had good summer help.

**Audience Comments:**

Trudy Delawder: Crime Watch now has an EIN number and checking account at PNC so everything is accounted for. PNC is going to give us a donation.

Jim Barnick, 203 Adams Ct.: Questioned if planning agency took any action on the landfill. It is a requirement under the land development and subdivision. It is a major land development. This council passed a motion.

Lukasewicz: Mr. Barnick raised concerns of planning and subdivision ordinance. The planning commission should have a prudent review of the landfill application as it conforms.

Barnick said a motion was passed.

Lukasewicz asked if it was forwarded to the planning commission. They should review the landfill expansion in regard to the borough ordinances as they adhere to planning and storm water and everything. It is only to protect the Borough.

Repchick added that Dunmore went through planning commission.

Barnick added that it has to go through the county too.

Barnick asked to make another motion so he can hear it.

Lukasewicz: If there was a motion made to pass on the request from the throop council to planning commission to review the landfill expansion at a prior meeting if that can be delegated to them and let them know about it. Barnick: Reporters used to stop at planning meetings to see what was going on.

Lukasewicz pass on to planning tomorrow.

Barnick: Can you request a second public meeting. They didn't even take a recording of what was asked. I can't get my comments in because I had to choose 2 questions.

Lokuta added that they are having their zoning hearing board on the height issue up there. They have scheduled 3 meetings for that anticipating lot of public input. That was in the paper.

Barnick: There was at least 500 people there. We need another meeting. And there was no stenographic record. It is all about hiding. Just want a request for another meeting.

Lukasewicz I don't have a problem requesting another one.

Discussion took place regarding how many meetings were requested.

Attorney Cimini follow up and request another public hearing.

Attorney Cimini added that he will call tomorrow.
