

ORDINANCE NUMBER 5 OF 2016

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A STOP SIGN AT THE CORNER OF LYNWOOD AND ERIE STREETS

WHEREAS, Throop Borough Council is aware of potential safety issue regarding vehicles entering Lynwood from Erie Street; and,

WHEREAS, Throop Borough authorized the Chief of Police to investigate all safety issues at Lynwood and Erie Streets; and,

WHEREAS, following an onsite inspection, Throop's Chief of Police, Keith Jones, recommended in a April 22, 2016 memorandum that a sight distance issue exists at the intersection of Erie Street and Lynwood Street involving vehicles entering Lynwood from Erie Street safely.

WHEREAS, to resolve the issue Chief Jones recommended installation of a stop sign on Lynwood Street at its intersection with Erie Street.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto intending to be legally bound hereby agree as follows:

1. The Street Commissioner and/or other Throop Official responsible for installation of traffic signs is authorized to install a stop sign on Lynwood Street at the intersection with Erie Street in conjunction with the Throop Chief of Police April 22, 2016 memorandum.

2. Subsequent to installation of the stop sign, enforcement will be handled by the Throop Police Department and penalties for violation will be as identified in Pennsylvania Statutes and Vehicle code.

SECTION 1.

If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough of Throop reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Ordinance and the effective administration thereof.


SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after its enactment.

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance is enacted by the Council of the Borough of Throop under the authority of the Act of the Legislative, as amended, December 12, 1990, P.L. 1994, No. 220, and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.


