To allow restaurants and bars in Throop Borough, on a temporary basis, to conduct food and alcohol sales immediately adjacent to or abutting and contiguous to the existing licensed premises. Council approval is contingent on the licensed premises obtaining a temporary extension of premise permit and complying with all guidelines proposed by PLCB. In addition, the licensed premises must name Throop Borough as an additional insured on all relevant policies, provide a certificate of insurance to Throop Borough and complete a special enforcement permit. The permit is only in effect until the ordinance is rescinded.

To adopt Resolution #3 of 2020, a resolution of the Borough of Throop authorizing the Board of Commissioners of Lackawanna County to submit an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development for funding, on behalf of Throop Borough in the amount of \$60,951.00, through the Community Development Block Grant-Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) Program, as part of the Coronavirus, Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act [P.L. 116-136], and further certifying compliance with the requirements of said program.
